The Barbados Vocational Training Board (BVTB) is seeking a qualified and skilled professional to join our team to fill the following vacant position:

DEMONSTRATOR

Core Function:

To plan, execute, manage and evaluate technical/vocational instruction in Tractor Operations at a Vocational Training Centre.

Duties include:

- Preparing instructional materials, including performance objectives, lesson plans, instructional aids, information materials and training modules.
- Demonstrating skills and explaining theoretical concepts in Farm Tractor Operations.
- Ensuring that all training is conducted in accordance with the required health and safety practices, and the Road Traffic Act.
- Directing field trips and arranging on-the-job training.
- Organizing and managing the training workshop for effective and efficient delivery of training.
- Performing preventative maintenance on tools, equipment and machinery.
- Maintaining electronic training records.
- Performing continuous assessment of the trainee's performance.
- Evaluating the ability of the trainee(s) at the end of the programme.
- Conducting interviews for the selection of participants.

Qualifications:

- a. A Caribbean Secondary Education Certificate in English Language (CSEC) General proficiency Level with no less than three (3) years' relevant experience in the discipline, and possession of one (1) of the following qualifications in said discipline:
