

LANDSCAPING

Trainees on the Landscaping course will receive practical skills including determining kinds and amounts of plants, setting up a nursery, planning and installing landscapes, performing preventative maintenance of tools, equipment and machinery. This trainees will allow them to respond to business opportunities in farming, horticulture, and nursery plant work.

The programme is of nine months duration (39 weeks) and is performance based in nature.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

On completion of training, the trainee will be able to:

- 1. Design and install a landscape
- Set up and manage a plant nursery composed of: -cut flowers
 -flower foliage; and
 - -potted plants
- 3. Maintain gardens, lawns and hedges
- 4. Set up and manage a garden shop profitably
